The worked in father's shop, later from doctor, then shop again. Was left photographic equipment by photographer James Tait. Became full time photographer in World War Two -- permit issued by Major Simpson in Stromness -- very busy. Outside photography not allowed, only portraits and groups. Had to notify police if photographing in people's houses. Scalloway population doubled in war. Changes, wife died about 24 years ago, "hardly know" population now. Getting materials in wartime, | | |

| | <p>rationed on use in 1938, 25 per cent or third of then purchases but could claim for military or government work. Did lot of work for Sullom flying boat base, taking photos for passes. Road Surveyor had to certify use. Wartime photographic supplies from Gothic Arcade, Birmingham, doesn't know how supplier managed to source material, but supplied paper at a price. Ramsay in Lerwick was "kinda hard up for stuff" - used a half of whole plate camera while CW used quarter plate. CW developed when customers were on site - could establish easily then if picture needed re-taking, saved material that way. New houses built in Scalloway just before war used as barracks, had to be renovated afterwards. More council house building after war. Lived in Scott's Haa as a boy - six tenants 28 folk, now empty. Many of the people moved to new council houses. People employed in fish factories, woollen industry, Scord Quarry, pay offs coming from oil industry. Loss of "Ben Doran", trawler was regular caller at Scalloway, skipper preached in kirks. Vessel had run about thirty years. Sequence of vessel going on Vee Skerries "must have made a terrible blunder." Spoke with ex-crewman who told of skipper pointing out Vee Skerries. Suggests that lighting of gas lamp on vessel (for gutting fish on board etc.) may have impaired skipper's vision. Improvements at Scalloway harbour. Writing - novels and short stories, always interested. Had story accepted by St. George's Magazine while at school. Took short story course at Regent Institute - six guineas. Got help from broadcaster Halbert Tatlock - wrote and asked him to look at work - strong critic, "butchered" - but wrote to CW later to ask if he'd got over the "onslaught." Came on better afterwards, and later had story broadcast. Lost contact, but later found Tatlock had died, via contact of Archie P. Lee. Trowie stories - feels they are not so possible in brightly lit society. No ghostly nature to Scalloway Castle, played in it as a boy. Has encountered places he felt haunted - old room in Scalloway smiddy. People said they could hear hammering even when nobody was in. Gott Schoolhouse got name of "uneasy place." Superstition -- story told him about Unst people leaving quickly at end of church service, so as not to be last person out of church in dark. Gallow Hill, some maps call it Witches Hill or Hill o Berry. Witches tried in Scalloway and executed. Church brought case against accused, condemned and burned the same day. Claims last witch burned 1732, Barbara Tulloch and her daughter Ellen King. George Nelson told that a man quarrelled with King, "I'll see dee burnt yet," - she replied "du'll hear about it bit du'll never see it." He was three times turned back on his way to the event. Ground near TV mast is supposed to be site. Part is without growth, ash layer about nine inch under surface. Marioune Pardoune executed there. Some traded on notion of witchcraft, and benefited from reputation. As boy heard of women in Scalloway who had that sort of repute. Superstitions in fishing industry. Swedish fishing effort - learned language in 1930's, later met ambassador. Visited Swedish fishermen in Gilbert Bain Hospital. Norwegians in Scalloway during World War Two - intelligibility of languages. Secrecy of Shetland Bus operation was maintained "dey wir very tight." Marriages in Scalloway with Norwegian servicemen. Other forces in Shetland during wartime - Polish. Ramsay photographer in Lerwick, very particular but quick with posing, high quality of his wedding photography. Importance of composition - "eyes must go wi da head." Modelled his work on Ramsay. Recommended by him when he retired. Did talk about Ramsay on Town and Country programme on radio. Shows first picture Ramsay took - had CW's mother in it, with aunt. They'd go to Lerwick to be photographed by Spence, told he wasn't in business and to go to Ramsay. Photo had No. 1 on the back, thinks Ramsay counted pictures from that one on. Abernethy Brothers, possibly longer in Lerwick than Ramsay, other photographers Charlie Coutts and [Jack] Hay, Thule Studios in Commercial Road, later Ethel Brown's the hairdresser. Tommy Pole also photographer. Feels modern photography would often benefit from going back to black and white. Cameras used for slides. Importance of good lens - "slides have to be sharp ...going to be blown up." Worked around exposure reading. Various films and character of - Fuji and Kodak emulsions. Black and white had a lot of latitude. Compensation with papers and developers. Experiments with sensitising own papers etc. Filmed by A. Smith.</p> | | |
